God's Method of Operation

- Noah – God spoke – 100 yrs before fulfillment
- Abraham – God spoke – 25 yrs before fulfillment
- Joseph – God spoke – 13 yrs before fulfillment
- Moses – Tried to deliver his people – 40 yrs in the desert as preparation
- David – God chose him and Samuel anointed him 13 yrs before he was crowned king

The Conquest

- Joshua – one of the original 10 spies and assistant to Moses.
“No man will be able to stand before you all the days of your life. Just as I have been with Moses, I will be with you; I will not fail you or forsake you. Be strong and courageous, for you shall give this people possession of the land which I swore to their fathers to give them.” Joshua 1:5-6
